The Colorado Agricultural Development Authority has committed \$5,000 in support of five \$1,000 scholarships for entering freshmen enrolling in agriculture. The scholarships may be used to attend any Colorado college or university with an accredited agriculture program.

## **Eligibility:**

1. Open to Colorado 4-H members in good standing
2. Recipients must attend a college or university in Colorado with an accredited agriculture program
3. Graduating high school senior a. Grade point average of B or higher
4. Financial need as indicated in the scholarship application
5. Evidence of being accepted by a college or university
6. Citizenship/leadership/community service (in 4-H, school and community)
7. Majoring in an agricultural field
8. Maintain a C or better grade point average while enrolled in college/university

## **Application Requirements:**

1. Completed Universal Scholarship Application Form with dates/signatures
2. Official copy of most recent high school transcript, signed by school officials
3. Minimum of three/maximum of four letters of recommendation from:
  - a. 4-H adult volunteer leader
  - b. Extension agent
  - c. Academic advisor, school official or teacher
  - d. Personal character reference
4. 1-3 page resume
5. Copy of acceptance document from a college/university in Colorado

## **Selection Process:**

Following each scholarship's criteria, recipients will be chosen by the selection committee, comprised of a 4-H Scholar, a 4-H Extension Specialist/4-H Youth Development, and a donor representative from one of the scholarships or a Foundation member.
